Applicant must not have any felony or gross misdemeanor convictions related to controlled substances within 36 months of submitting an application. 3. Applicant must obtain a high school diploma or its equivalent. 4. Applicant can have no history of drug abuse or provide satisfactory evidence of rehabilitation. 5. Applicant must submit a technician-in-training application (\$15) which is valid for two years and non-renewable. A waiver must also be submitted to the board. This serves as work permit until the applicant is qualified to become a technician. Applicants must contact the Wyoming board of pharmacy for applications. 6. Applicant must provide evidence of current certification by a board-approved certification program. 7. Applicant must submit an application (must request from Wyoming board of pharmacy) for licensure as a technician.
